

RESOLUTION NO. RES-2020-022

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA ESTABLISHING THE OLIVE PARK RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ZONE

WHEREAS, the Finance Department received a petition from residents of the 200 block of Olive Street between Hazel Street and Laurel Street and the 300 block of Orange Street located south of Laurel Street requesting the creation of a new Olive Park Residential Permit Parking Zone; and

WHEREAS, City Code Section 11-44.050 establishes the procedure for creating Residential Permit Parking Zones; and

WHEREAS, the petition represents 62% of residential units on the 200 block of Olive (8 of 13) and 71% of residential units on the 300 block of Orange (5 of 7) proposed for inclusion in the Olive Park Residential Permit Parking Zone, depicted on the attached Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, staff held a Neighborhood Meeting with residents, on December 4, 2019, to review the issues and discuss the merits of establishing the Olive Park Residential Permit Parking Zone; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that these blocks meet the City's requirements for inclusion in the Residential Permit Parking Program; and

WHEREAS, staff and residents have reached agreement on parking restrictions, including a 2-hour time limit from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Santa Rosa approves the establishment of the Olive Park Residential Permit Parking Zone in the 200 block of Olive Street between Hazel Street and Laurel Street and the 300 block of Orange Street located south of Laurel Street, as depicted in Exhibit A attached to this resolution.
