ISSUE(S)

Shall City Council, by resolution, authorize the City Manager or her designee to accept funds from the County of Sonoma related to revenues from AB 109 Public Safety Realignment and funds from the Board of State and Community Corrections?



COUNCIL GOALS AND STRATEGIES

Relates to Council Goal 6: Commit to Making Santa Rosa a Healthy Community Where People Feel Safe to Live, Work, and Play.

The Santa Rosa Police Department's Mission Statement is "We are committed to making Santa Rosa a safe place to live, work and play."

BACKGROUND

- As part of the Public Safety Realignment, State revenues are provided to the County of Sonoma. The County of Sonoma will provide a portion of those revenues to the City of Santa Rosa.
- Funds have also been allocated to the Board of State and Community Corrections. The City of Santa Rosa is scheduled to receive funds and act as a fiscal agent for these funds.
- 3. These funds will be used for a variety of enforcement activities, including but not limited to salary costs and overtime.

ANALYSIS

The Police Department is requesting that the City Council authorize the City Manager or her designee to accept these funds as they are received. This action will assist in the timely use of the funds and will not require the Police Department to return to Council each time funds are received.

RECOMMENDATION
