WHEREAS, the preservation, history and culture is shared with all by offering a variety of social, cultural and political events; and


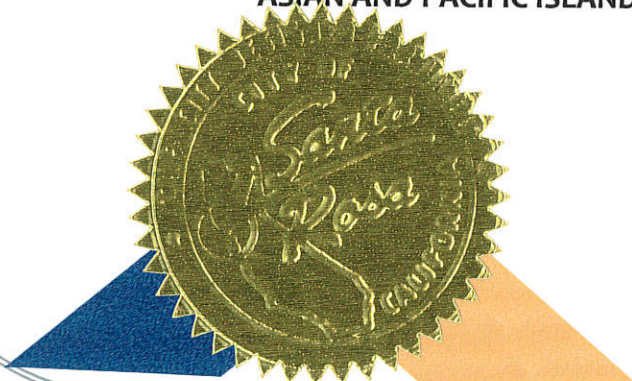
