



Creekside Aerial Map







Park Naming Policy & Procedure

- The name enhances City's values & heritage. Compatible with community interest.
- To easily identify parks by geographic location/function
- To encourage land/monetary donations & provide recognition

Change of Name

- A park or recreation facility name may be changed if the following conditions are met:
 - A. Occurrence or event of national or local significance. A waiting period of no less than two (2) years between the event and the actual naming of the park is required.
 - B. If the name becomes inappropriate.

Mary M. Traverso


- Co-founded Bennett Valley Vision in 2005

 She is loved by her family and known in the community from Traverso's Market









Question 1: Where do you live within the City of Santa Rosa?




Question 1: Where do you live within the City




Question 10: Are Mary M. Traverso's civic contributions an "occurrence or event of national or local significance"?




Question 11: Does changing the Creekside Open Space park name to Mary M. Traverso "enhance the City's values and heritage"?




Question 12: Is changing the Creekside Open Space park name to Mary M. Traverso "compatible with community interest"?

Findings

- 69% of respondents living in Southeast Santa Rosa support a name change if there is 50% or greater support for the name change
- 64% of All Respondents support a name change if there is 50% or greater support for the name change.
- 66% of respondents living in Santa Rosa support a name change if there is 50% or greater support for the name change.





Board of Community Services Recommends

Approving the park name change from Creekside Open Space to Mary Traverso Open Space with 73% of Southeast resident respondents and 62% of City resident respondents in favor. This is 12% above the threshold of support favored by all meeting attendees and respondents to change the name of park land.
