



CITY OF SANTA ROSA NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

PUBLIC HEARING - SUBMITTAL OF SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN (HOME-ARP) ALLOCATION PLAN TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT; AND APPROVAL OF SECOND AMENDMENT TO GRANT AGREEMENT WITH CATHOLIC CHARITIES HOME-ARP PROGRAM (\$1,719,539).

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be conducted by the City Council on Tuesday August 19, 2025 at or after 5:00 p.m. The purpose of the public hearing will be to receive public comments on the City of Santa Rosa's draft Substantial Amendment to the Home Investment Partnerships – American Rescue Plan (HOME-ARP) Allocation Plan (Substantial Amendment) prior to the City Council acting on authorizing submittal of to the Substantial Amendment to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

The Substantial Amendment includes an additional allocation of HOME-ARP funds (\$4,095) from HUD, increasing the total allocation to \$2,741,528; and the reallocation of \$100,000 from City Administration and Planning to subrecipient Supportive Services and Non-Profit Operating Costs, aligning with the City's original intent to prioritize funds for programs that prevent and address homelessness. The \$104,095 will be awarded to Catholic Charities HOME-ARP Program via a Second Amendment to Grant Agreement, bringing the total agreement to \$1,719,539 for the period January 1, 2024, through June 30, 2026.
