## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED INCREASES AND/OR REVISIONS TO MISCELLANEOUS FEES AND CHARGES FOR WATER AND WASTEWATER RELATED SERVICES

The purpose of the public hearing will be to receive oral or written public comment prior to the Board of Public Utilities action on the proposal to increase and/or revise miscellaneous fees and charges for water and wastewater related services.

If you cannot attend, you are encouraged to submit written comments prior to the public hearing. Written comments submitted to the Board of Public Utilities at the address listed below and received prior to the close of the public hearing on December 15, 2022, will be presented to the Board at the public hearing.
