RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO INCREASE APPROPRIATIONS FOR AN URBAN STREAMS RESTORATION GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$550,000 FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES FOR THE LOWER COLGAN CREEK RESTORATION – PHASE I PROJECT

WHEREAS, the California Department of Water Resources, Division of Planning and Local Assistance, Urban Streams Restoration Program has awarded a grant in the amount of \$550,000 to the City of Santa Rosa for the Lower Colgan Creek Restoration – Phase I Project; and

WHEREAS, the grant agreement was executed on September 24, 2013 and authorized by Council Resolution 27275; and

WHEREAS, said grant projects are intended to help solve flooding and erosion problems in a way that provides environmental enhancement; and

WHEREAS, the Redwood Empire Chapter of Trout Unlimited has co-sponsored the project with the City of Santa Rosa.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Santa Rosa authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to increase appropriations to the project account JL Key 54007, Lower Colgan Creek Restoration Project in the amount of \$550,000, the source of the funds being the grant award from the California Department of Water Resources.
