



Contract Award – Flashing Yellow Left Turn Arrow Retrofit

BACKGROUND

- This project will retrofit 39 signalized intersections with flashing yellow left turn arrow (FYA)
- FYA signals have been adopted to reduce congestion, confusion and crashes at intersections
- Project design and construction is 100% grant funded

ANALYSIS

- The project was advertised on 6/27/19; two bids were received on 7/18/19, ranging from \$456,998.00 to \$655,686.00.
- The low bid was 31.9% below the Engineer's estimate.
- Construction is anticipated to begin in January of 2020 and last 80 working days.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that Council, by motion, award Contract No. C02091, Flashing Yellow Left Turn Arrow Retrofit, in the amount of \$456,998.00 to the lowest responsible bidder, DC Electric Group, Inc., of Cotati, California, approve a 20% contract contingency, and authorize a total contract amount of \$548,397.60. The source of the funds is the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) Cycle 8 Federal Grant. No General Fund money is included in this project.
