SUMMARY

- Seeking approval for Sustained Reduction rebate for Amy's Kitchen for closed-loop cooling system
- Seeking delegation of authority to Director to approve future Sustained Reduction rebates



BACKGROUND

- Water-Use Efficiency Sustained Reduction Rebate Program
 - Hardware or process changes that result in sustained savings
 - \$200 per 1,000 gallons avg monthly reduction in demand
 - Program cost effective at
 - \$362 per AF for rebate
 - \$918 per AF wholesale


Closed Loop Kettle Deck Cooling Water

* Recycles water used for cooling instead of single pass





ANALYSIS



ANALYSIS



- Project is complete and water savings is estimated to be nearly 1 million gallons/month
- Eligible for up to \$200,000
- Delegating signature authority to Director would allow staff to more efficiently administer the program

FISCAL IMPACT

- Sustained Reduction Rebate Program funded by budget appropriations annually
 - Each rebate is subject to approval
 - Rebates are limited to available funding
- Amy's rebate approx. \$200,000
 - Funding was included in approved Water Department budget
- Signature authority for future rebates will be limited to appropriated funding
- Director will update Board for large rebates





WATER CONSERVATION SUBCOMMITTEE

- Considered this item on July 9th
- Unanimously recommended that the Board
 - Approve the rebate for Amy's Kitchen and
 - Delegate signature authority for future rebates to the Water Director.



RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Water Conservation
 Subcommittee of the Board and Water Department staff
 that the Board, by resolution,
 - ✓ Approve the Sustained Reduction rebate for Amy's Kitchen,
 - ✓ Authorize the Water Director or designee to approve the rebate, and
 - ✓ Delegate authority to the Director or designee to approve future Sustained Reduction rebates.
