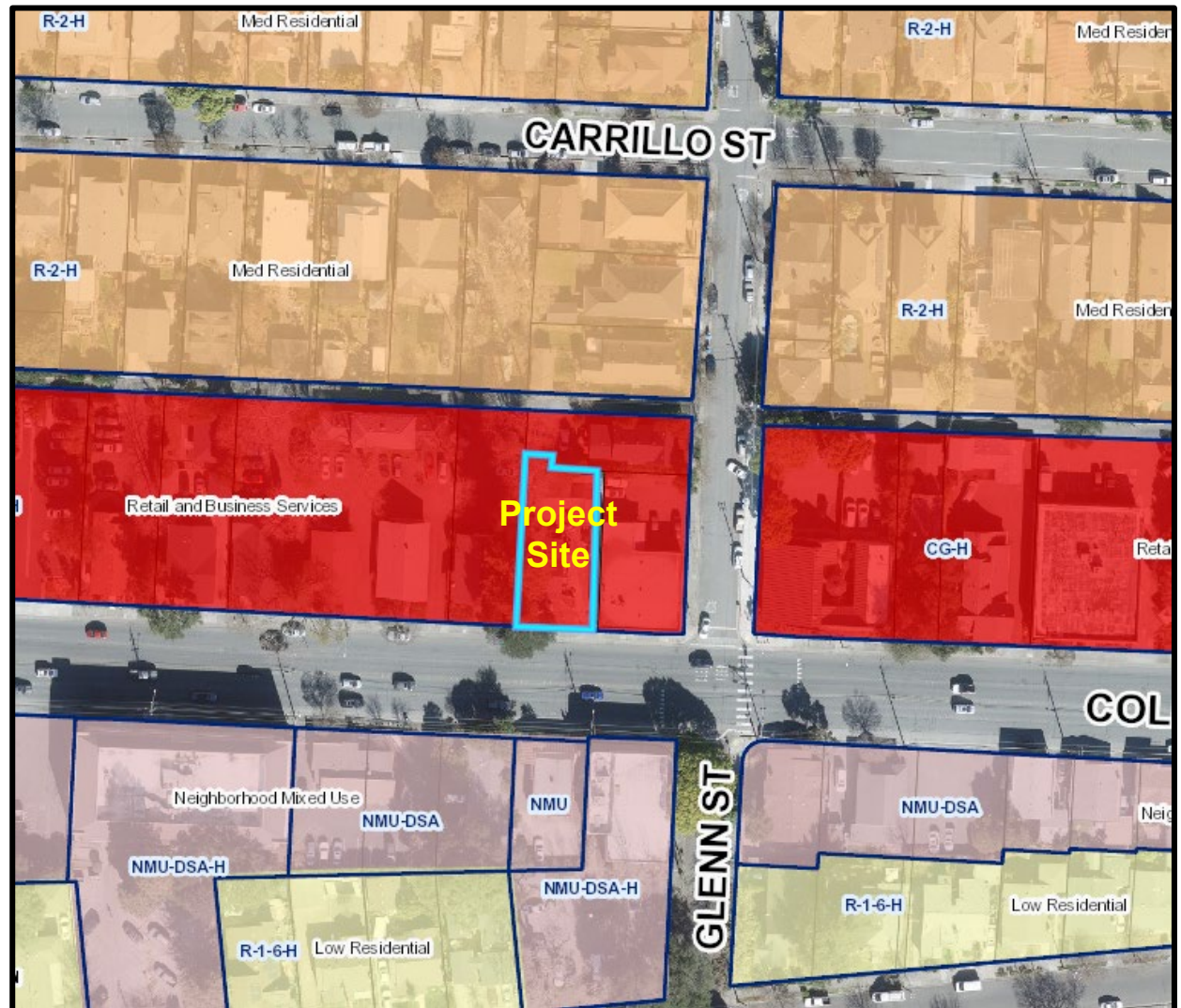

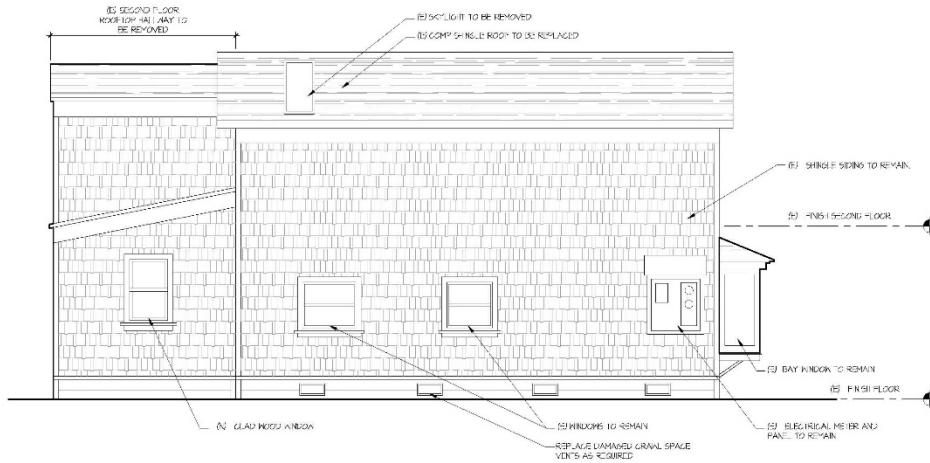

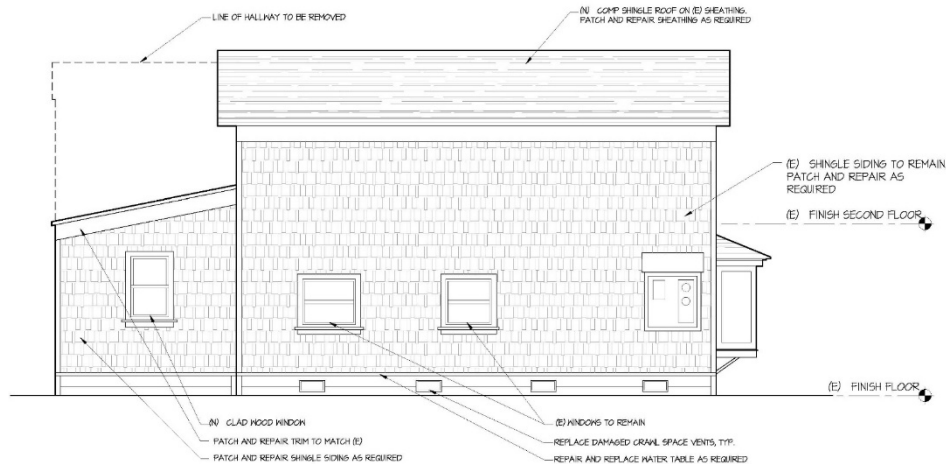

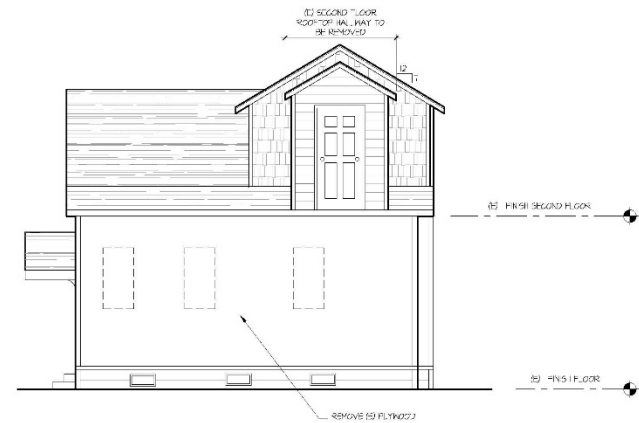

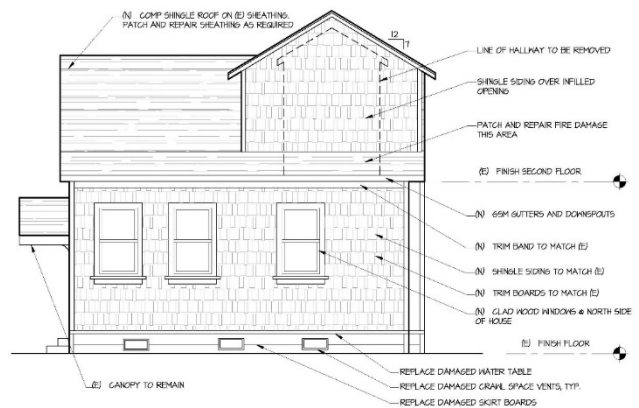
3 EXISTING WEST ELEVATION

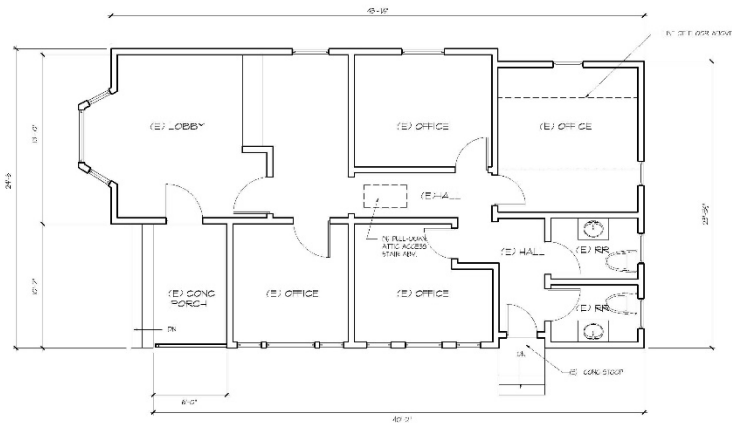


4 EXISTING NORTH ELEVATION

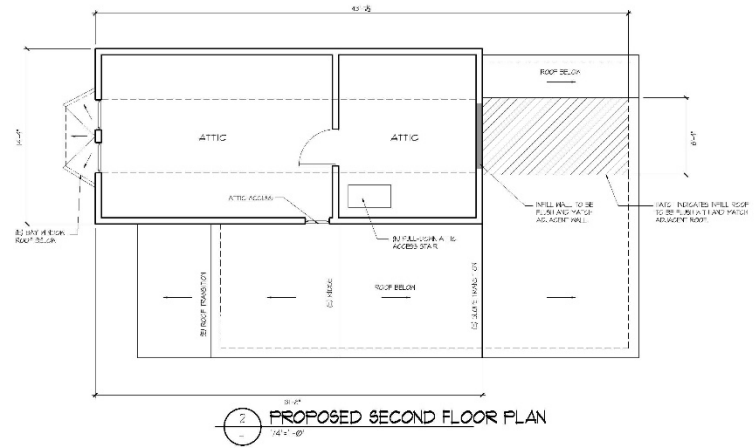

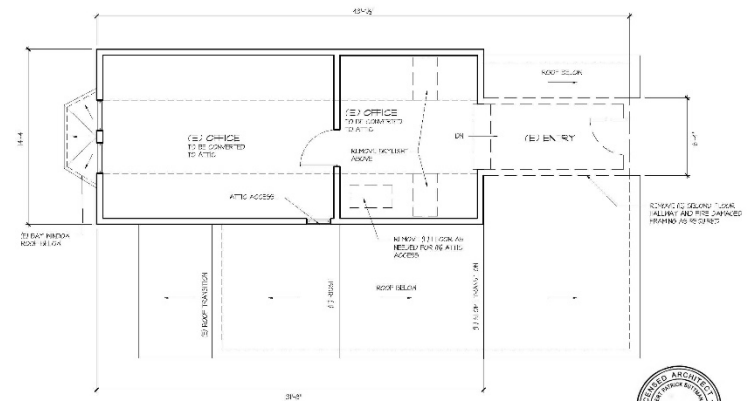
349 College Ave Floor Plan
