



Contract Award – Accessibility Alterations at Skyhawk Park

BACKGROUND

- A Certified Access Specialist inspected Skyhawk Park for disability access.
- Skyhawk Park project will remove and reconstruct existing pathways for the purpose of compliance with the Americans with Disability Act.
- This project will provide an accessible route to Skyhawk Park playground and soccer fields.
- The pathways will be reconstructed within the same footprint as the existing pathways.

ANALYSIS

- The project was advertised for bids on November 21, 2016, and bids were received on December 13, 2016.
- Eight bids received ranging from \$335,766.00 to \$436,277.00.
- Yukon Construction, Inc. of Santa Rosa, California was the lowest responsible bidder.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that the Council, by motion, award construction Contract No. C02082, Accessibility Alterations at Skyhawk Park, in the amount of \$335,766.00 to the lowest responsible bidder, Yukon Construction, Inc., of Santa Rosa, California, approve a 15% contingency, and authorize a total contract amount of \$386,130.90.
