Project Location




PD 98-003 (Planned Development)

- **November 1, 2024** - Notice of Application distributed
- **April 25, 2025** - Planning Commission public hearing notice distributed

Criteria for Review

- Public convenience or necessity;
- Crime rates compared to other areas;
- Concentration of alcohol licenses;
- Alcohol-related crime in and surrounding areas;
- Proximity to schools, parks, daycares, and religious sites; and
- Site design features that reduce loitering, improve visibility, and ensure safety.



Environmental Review

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)

Reviewed in compliance with CEQA:

- CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 -Involves a negligible expansion to an existing convenience store (General Retail)
- CEQA Guidelines Section 15183 -Consistent with General Plan
- CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 -No reasonable possibility project will have a significant effect on the environment

Public Comments

- The sale of alcoholic beverages from a gas station
- Support for the off-site sale of beer and wine at this location



- There are no unresolved issues as a result of staff review.
- Staff analysis has concluded findings can be met. The applicant has reviewed and accepted the Conditions of Approval.
