

RESOLUTION NO. RES-2022-173

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF TWO TYPE 5 SKEETER BRUSH TRUCKS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$678,000

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has a need to purchase two Type 5 Skeeter Brush Trucks; and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Contract for Cooperative Purchasing 10-2428 between the City and the Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) authorizes the City to utilize H-GAC cooperative purchase agreements; and

WHEREAS, Contract No. FS12-19 between H-GAC Buy and Golden State Fire Apparatus, Inc. is a competitively awarded contract for the purchase of fire service apparatus which allows other local government agencies to purchase equipment under this contract; and

WHEREAS, the City's agreement with H-GAC would allow the City to buy the two Type 5 Skeeter Brush Trucks at a favorable price.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Santa Rosa delegates authority to the City Manager or designee to utilize cooperative purchasing through the Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) through H-GAC vendor Golden State Fire Apparatus, Inc., Sacramento, CA for the purchase of two Type 5 Skeeter Brush Trucks in an amount not to exceed \$678,000 including approval of the issuance of any purchase orders and inclusion of Proposal terms and conditions from the vendor in substantially the same form as Exhibit A to the resolution, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council delegates authority to the City Manager or designee to negotiate and execute the any other documents, agreements or amendments related to the purchase that are in a form approved by the City Attorney.
