PETITION IN OPPOSITION TO THE CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT ISSUED FOR FOX DEN DISPENSARY AT 4036 MONTGOMERY DRIVE

Petition:The Santa Rosa Planning Commission approved a conditional use permit for Fox Den Dispensary (retail location for medical and adult use cannabis dispensary) at 4036 Montgomery Dr., Suite B, which is immediately in front of Kiwi Preschool & Childcare. The preschool, which has been in operation for 28 years, is a licensed preschool and day care center. Currently, Kiwi teaches approximately 50 preschool children and 16 children that are enrolled in the "TK Program" which is geared to preparing children for Kindergarten. This proposed dispensary location shares a property line with the preschool playground yard where children ages 2-5 years old play much of the day.

Specific to the approval of the conditional use permit by the Santa Rosa Planning Commission, we point the Council to fact that the required "findings" necessary to approve a conditional use permit in this situation have not been met: 1) the design, location, size and operating characteristics of the proposed activity are NOT compatible with the existing and future land uses in the vicinity; 2) the site is NOT physically suitable for the type, density and intensity of the use proposed; and 3) granting the permit would be injurious and/or detrimental to the public interest, health, safety, convenience, or welfare, or materially injurious to persons in the vicinity and zoning district in which the property is located.

Accordingly, the residents request the Santa Rosa City Council to overturn the Planning Commission's approval of the conditional use permit for Fox Den Dispensary. Additionally, if the Council is uncertain whether to support this petition, we the residents urge the Council to defer action on this matter so that further empirical analysis can be completed so that the Council can thoroughly evaluate such analysis. Analysis to date, including the anticipated increase in traffic in an already congested location is limited and inadequate.

We, the undersigned, call on the Santa Rosa City Council to overturn the Santa Rosa Planning Commission's approval of the conditional use permit for Fox Den Dispensary.

On January 24th the Santa Rosa Planning Commission approved Conditional Use Permit 18-076 for Fox Den Dispensary located at 4036 Montgomery Drive, Suite B, directly behind Trail House. An appeal of this decision, initiated by Kiwi Preschool & Daycare, to the Santa Rosa City Council has been filed and will come up on the City Council's agenda on April 9th. Trail House supports this appeal on the basis of site incompatibility, as we believe the increased traffic and additional burden on the lots limited parking creates a dangerous environment for you, our customers.

To be clear, we are not anti-cannabis. Our support of this appeal is only based on our belief a second high intensity retail store on the premises is not compatible with the site.

Many of you are frequent Trail House customers and are already familiar with the difficulties in parking and traffic flow with just one high intensity business on the lot. If you want to make your voice heard in this matter, please sign our petition, which we will present to the City Council during the appeal.

A couple sentence email supporting the appeal and offering your own experiences of the difficulties parking and driving the lot is all that is required.

Finally, if you are able to join us at City Hall on April 9th we would welcome your support in person. City Council values the quantity of opposition, and support, for these issues so a strong showing will benefit us all. We will send a follow up email closer to the City Council meeting when there is a listed agenda and time.





But 23 states have legalized marijuana for medicinal purposes which opens the door to expanding its use for recreational purposes, creating a potential boom in the development of dispensaries. Thus the need to data on specialty land uses like marijuana dispensaries.

One outstanding question is what is driving the high trip generation numbers. The high trip generation rates for marijuana dispensaries may be due to their newness. Krispy Kreme stores generated tremendous amounts of traffic when they first opened in Minnesota. Traffic died down after the newness wore off to the point where the Krispy Kreme stores are all out of business in Minnesota fifteen years later. We'll monitor the traffic generated by marijuana dispensaries to see if their trip generation rates decrease. We'll also work to add data from dispensaries outside of Colorado to make sure there isn't a location bias in the data.

- I am the Architect who worked with Glenn, Shane, and Specialized on the Trail House project in 2016.
- Trail House is on a small site with intensive bicycle, pedestrian, and vehicular activity.
 Realization of the Trail House project required a considerable amount of site study, so I am familiar with many of the site characteristics that make it challenging.
- I understand that almost the entire City Council membership has been able to visit the site personally and meet with the staff. This is much appreciated.
- The site has existing features that predate Trail House and are non-compliant with current standards.
 - Trail House made site improvements to mitigate these deficiencies, but existing site constraints did not allow them to be completely eliminated.
 - O Their impact will be magnified with the presence of a second intensive use and could impact visitor safety.
- The current Planning submittal by Fox Den includes 4 potentially design variations. None of them address issues that I think would need to be resolved to meet Code requirements. These issues include vehicle access, pedestrian access, and life safety.
 - Existing vehicle access
 - Existing site conditions do not allow compliant vehicular circulation.
 - Backup space is too short.
 - Site visibility and navigational space are impacted by existing features.
 - Trail House removed a storage structure (concrete pad remains) at the back of their building to improve vehicular circulation.
 - This allows 1-way loop circulation through the site which is more compatible with limited navigational space.
 - o Increased customer flow and safety.
 - Trail House was approved with a site parking count reduction from 27 to 17 (Zoning Clearance letter 5/20/2016).
 - Parking requirements for Fox den add 5 spaces to the site count which includes their staff parking.
 - Without the reduction for Trail House, the site parking requirement would be 32.
 - Proposed vehicle access

- The Fox Den appeal response letter indicates that their business model encourages rapid customer turnover.
 - o By default, these customers are going to be transaction focused and are making a quick stop.
- Trail House presents an informal atmosphere that encourages a more social atmosphere.
 - o They are more likely to spend time onsite visiting with friends and the local community.

Trail House has become a force multiplier for the outdoor community in Santa Rosa and a neighborhood gathering place. This unique business, in a neighborhood currently impacted with traffic and parking issues, is on a land parcel that cannot support another retail use as currently proposed.


1. Small sample size that Santa Rose City Staff used for projecting parking needs for this ever-evolving industry is unknown


The Applicant's response with regard to parking primarily relies on citing "city code" to say that the proposed parking supply will be adequate. However, the city's code requirements for Cannabis Retail (dispensary) and delivery is simply the exact same requirement that applies to most retail businesses in Santa Rosa (i.e. one space per 250 square feet, which equates to 4 spaces per thousand square feet).

It appears that, given the previous lack of data on parking demand generated by cannabis dispensaries when the City adopted cannabis regulations in 2017, the city applied the "default" parking requirement to cannabis dispensaries. However, the city's parking code requirement is quite a bit lower than the ITE parking demand data that Kiwi cited in the peer review letter (peak demand of 20.7 spaces per thousand, and average demand of 7.19 spaces per thousand square feet). Parking code requirements are typically intended to accommodate the "peak" demand that occurs during busy times of the day (not just the "average" demand).

2. The Applicant and W-Trans failed to respond to the ITE parking demand data

Where W-Trans states that 50 trips per hour (thus 25 customers per hour) would only need 6 spaces (assuming 15-minute visits for each customer), that statement assumes that (a) there would be no overlap between departing and arriving passengers; (b) it assumes that customers will be evenly distributed between each 15-minute block (i.e. no more than 6 customers during each 15-minute block). In reality, though, there will be overlap between departing and arriving passengers (i.e. if Customer A arrives at 4:03 and leaves at 4:18, while Customer B arrives at 4:15 and leaves at 4:30, there's overlap). That peak demand reflects the fact that the number of customers will fluctuate from one 15-minute period to the next).
