RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) BETWEEN THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA AND CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY, SONOMA TO IMPLEMENT THE SUSTAINABLE CITIES INITIATIVE

WHEREAS, “Sustainable Cities” is a national model for partnerships between cities and universities. The model provides opportunities for university students to identify solutions to local challenges, present new and innovative ideas to cities, and make a difference in the community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Rosa and Sonoma State University desire to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the purpose of working together on various “Sustainable Cities” initiatives for the City, and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the City and University will enter into a separate agreement for the implementation and completion of sustainable cities initiatives arising from this MOU.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Santa Rosa approves the Memorandum of Understanding with Sonoma State University attached hereto as Exhibit A and authorizes the Mayor to execute it.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Exhibit A is made part of this Resolution.
