EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In consideration of rent stabilization, an overview of the Santa Rosa rental housing market will be conducted and laws relating to rent stabilization will be reviewed. Experience of other California cities, already involved in rent stabilization, or those cities considering adoption of a rent stabilization program, will be reviewed.

BACKGROUND

The City Council Work plan established a study session to discuss rent stabilization options for Santa Rosa.

ANALYSIS

During the preparation and update of its work plan, the City Council identified rent stabilization and just cause eviction issues as an option to be discussed and evaluated.
