RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Housing and Community Services Department that the Housing Authority hold a Study Session to review the draft FY 2018/19 budget. This item is for information only and no action is requested.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of this Study Session is to provide an overview of the draft FY 2018/19 budget for the Housing Authority's review and commentary.

BACKGROUND

The Housing Authority's annual budget process runs concurrently with the City's, from January through June each year, and consists of two study sessions and the budget hearings. The Housing Authority held a study session at the February 26, 2018 meeting to provide direction and hear public commentary on the FY 2018/19 budget. The Authority will review the proposed FY 2018/19 budget at study session today. Budget hearings will be held on June 18, 2018 when the Authority will be asked to approve the budget for FY 2018/19 before it goes to the City Council for final approval later that week.

PRIOR HOUSING AUTHORITY REVIEW

On February 26, 2018 the Housing Authority conducted a study session to provide commentary and hear from the public on the annual budget process.
