



State of Good Repair (SGR) Funding Request

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CURRENT

- State Transit Assistance (STA) funding from the State of Good Repair (SGR) account authorized under SB1 (2017) is generated from a portion of a new transportation improvement fee on vehicle registration
- The SGR program goal is to provide funding to rehabilitate and modernize California's existing local transit systems

PROPOSED

- Request \$26,379 in annual formula SGR funds that Santa Rosa Transportation and Public Works Department will use to maintain and repair the fixed-route fleet of buses.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that the Council, by resolution, approve the SB1 State of Good Repair Project List, and authorize the Director of Transportation and Public Works or designee to request the City's annual allocation of FY 2022-23 State of Good Repair funding in the estimated amount of \$26,379 from the California Department of Transportation.
