- A. City and Contractor entered into the Agreement for Contractor to provide tree services. The First Amendment extended the term of the Agreement. The Second Amendment extended the term of the Agreement. An extension letter was issued to extend the term of the Agreement for one year. A second letter of extension was issued to extend the term of the Agreement for one year. The Third Amendment increased compensation.
- B. City and Contractor now desire to amend the Agreement for the purpose of increasing compensation.

<u>AMENDMENT</u>

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

COMPENSATION

Section 4 of the Agreement is amended to increase the compensation payable to Contractor under the Agreement by \$300,000 to read as follows:

"The total of all fees paid to Contractor for the satisfactory performance and completion of all services set forth in the Agreement shall not exceed the total sum of \$1,000,000. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to pay all proper claims from various Charge Numbers."

All other terms of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
