



Master Agreement (Agency-State For State-Funded Projects) with Caltrans

Background

- The City is required to enter into a Master Agreement with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) as well as a Program Supplement to the Master Agreement for transportation projects, before state funds can be committed to the City.
- It has been 13 years since the last State Master Agreement revision. To address changing State regulations and policies, Caltrans has revised the Master Agreement.
- Master Agreements have previously been executed by the City Council for state funded transportation projects. By resolution, the TPW Director has been authorized to execute Program Supplement Agreements for individual federal transportation projects.

Recommendation

It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that Council, by resolution: 1) approve the Master Agreement Administering Agency-State Agreement for State-Funded Projects with the California Department of Transportation in order to obtain state funds for construction of eligible transportation projects; and 2) authorize the Director of Transportation and Public Works to execute Program Supplement Agreements for specific projects.
