Santa Rosa BACKGROUND

Santa Rosa PROPOSED CODE CHANGES

Definition Changes to:

- "Authorized Representative"
- "Significant Industrial User" to include
 "Non-Significant Categorical Industrial User"
- "Significant Non-Compliance"
- Chemical listing in Local Limits (instead of references)

Santa Rosa RECOMMENDATION

 The Utilities Department recommends that the City Council adopt an Ordinance amending certain sections of Santa Rosa City Code Title – 15 Sewers: 15-04.030 to add the definition of Non-Significant Categorical Industrial User and update the definition of Authorized Representative,15-06.120 to complete Significant Non-Compliance criteria and 15-08.100 to add chemical lists to local limits.
