



Approval of Fifth Amendment to General Service Agreement Number F001647 with ADT Commercial LLC – Fire Suppressions Systems Inspection, Maintenance, Service, and Testing

CURRENT

- Routine inspections of the fire suppression systems in City facilities are required periodically to maintain operational capabilities in the event of a fire.
- The City uses a licensed contractor to provide these services.

PROPOSED

- Approve the Fifth Amendment to General Service Agreement number F001647 to extend the Agreement for one-year and increase compensation in the amount of \$120,000.

BENEFIT

- Ensures all fire suppression systems citywide are compliant with National Fire Protection Association standards.
- Makes certain that the systems and associated equipment are functional at all times.
- Promotes workplace safety and mitigates potential fire damage to City properties.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Finance Department, that the Council, by resolution, approve the Fifth Amendment to General Services Agreement Number F001647 for inspection, maintenance, and repair services to maintain the operational functionality of fire suppression systems and their appurtenances, with ADT Commercial LLC, Boca Raton, Florida, to extend the Agreement one-year with a 3% increase in unit cost and increase compensation in the amount of \$120,000, for a total not to exceed amount of \$708,144.
