- May 29 – Howarth Park snack bar reopens with social distancing & COVID safety procedures in place.
- June 7 – Summer Adult Softball League Play begins at Northwest, Galvin, Franklin, and Howarth fields (M-F evenings).
- June 8 – The front counters at Finley & Steele Lane Community Centers will reopen to the general public
- June 12 – Rec Swim begins at Finley Aquatics Center; Ridgway Rec swim begins 6/14. Locker rooms & showers are still not open due to COVID protocols.
- June 14 – August 12 – Summer Daze at Wa-tam located in Howarth Park will run Monday-Thursday this summer, serving 65 kids per week while social distancing and following State & local COVID guidance. Campers will enjoy canoeing, songs, skits, crafts, nature, special guests, hiking and swimming at Spring Lake. This program filled for the entire summer within 10 hours of registration opening.
- June 14 – August 5 – Summer Daze at Yu-Chi located in Youth Park will run Monday-Thursday this summer, serving 55 kids per week while social distancing and following State & local COVID guidance. Campers will enjoy songs, skits, crafts, nature, special guests, hiking, field trips, and swimming at Finley Aquatic Center. Program full by 5/17.
- June 14 – Summer swim lessons begin with instructors back in the water teaching. Lap swim, water fitness, masters, & water polo will continue with on-line reservations only.
- June 18 – Senior *ZEST* newsletter will be mailed to senior members, listing reopening activities & programs.
- June 20 – Doyle and Franklin Clubhouses reopen for ongoing rental groups.
- June 21 – Finley Person Senior Wing and the Steele Lane Community Center will begin offering senior programs. This will be done in 3 phases as we focus on programs that comply with COVID safety guidance. Now taking pre-reservations for billiards, bingo, legal consultations and dementia care support.
- June 21 – Neighborhood Services *Better Together* camps will begin. Camp locations at Steele Lane Community Center, Finley Community Center, Northwest Park, Southwest Park, and Bayer Park. Approximately 250 kids will be served.

ACCOMPLISHED EVENTS:

- April 30 – Kentucky Derby themed Senior Lunch a success! Over 30 seniors enjoyed a drive-thru Chick-fil-A lunch and gift.
- May 6 - Registration for Summer programs began! As of 5/17:
 - 2,921 online registrations (88%)
 - 380 phone/in-person registrations (12%)
 - 54% of all our summer services are still available.
- May 14 – Summer Adult Softball registration completed. 82 teams registered
- May 15 – Picnic reservations have resumed in all parks except for Doyle Park.
- May 26 – Last Day of School of Rec! The recreation division supported students the entire 20/21 school year offering distance learning support & day care daily 7:30am-5:30pm at all three community centers (Steele Lane, Finley, and Person Senior Wing). It was a tremendous challenge and accomplishment to organize and run this valuable program during the pandemic.
