PROGRAMS AND REBATES

WaterSmart Check-up:

Get a free onsite check-up of your indoor and outdoor water use for your home, business, or multi-family residential sites.

Cash for Grass:

Conserve water by replacing the underutilized grass at your home or business with a low water-use landscape.*

Pre and post inspections required.



Irrigation Upgrade:

Schedule a pre-inspection to qualify for upgrades to your existing irrigation equipment, which may include pressure regulation, drip irrigation retrofit, high-efficiency sprinkler nozzles, spray bodies with pressure regulation and check valves, rain or weather sensor, and a water-conserving controller.

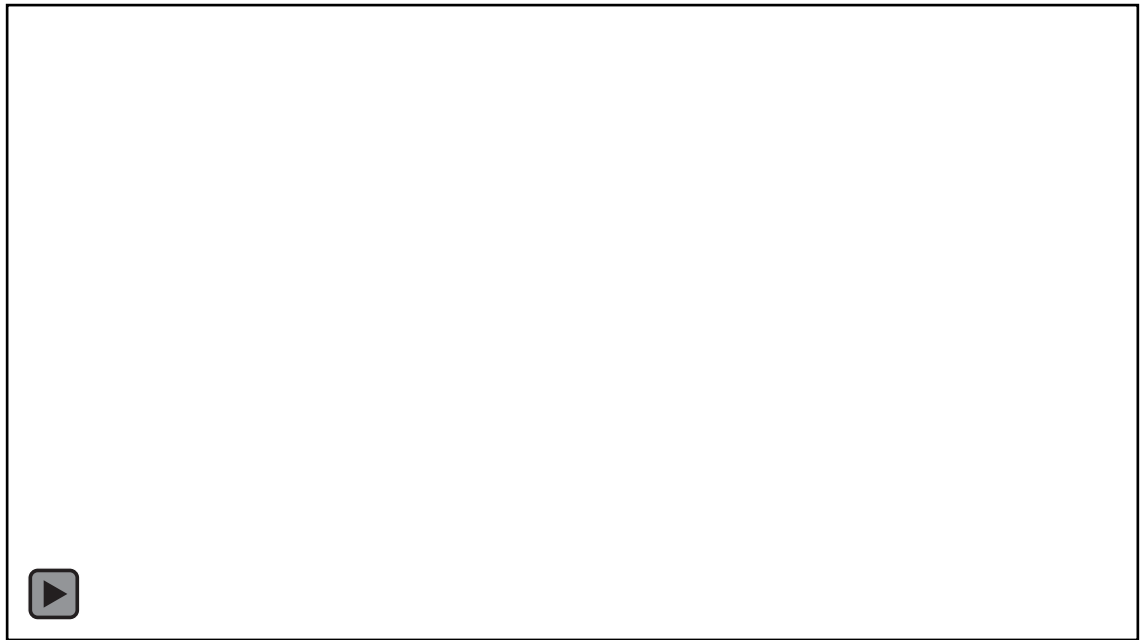

First Saturday Cleanup on Prince Memorial Greenway (ages 5 and up)

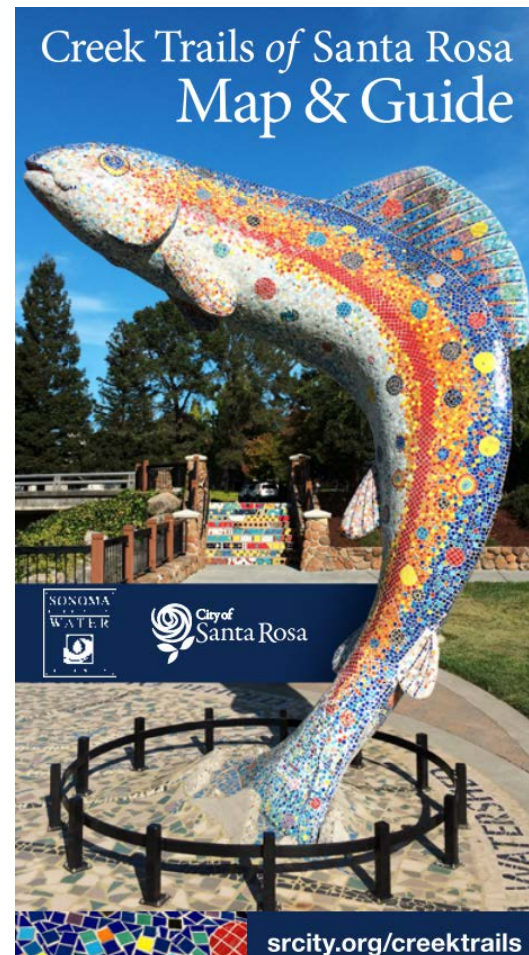
