



TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT (TDA) ARTICLE 3 GRANT APPLICATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022/2023

BACKGROUND

- Transportation Development Act (TDA) funds are generated from a statewide ¼ cent sales tax. Article 3 of TDA sets aside of approximately 2% of those monies for bicycle and pedestrian planning and projects. The Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) administers TDA Article 3, which is distributed based on population.
- The City annually receives TDA Article 3 funding for bicycle and pedestrian projects.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that Council, by resolution, request that the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) allocate \$600,000 from Fiscal Year (FY) 2022/2023 Transportation Development Act (TDA) Article 3 funds; authorize the Director of Transportation and Public Works to file the application and other required documents to construct Highway 101 Bicycle and Pedestrian Overcrossing; and increase appropriations by \$600,000 of TDA Article 3 funds to JL Key 17381.
