



General Services Agreement Approval – Fire Suppressions Systems Inspection, Maintenance, Service, and Testing

CURRENT

- Routine inspections of the fire suppression systems in City facilities are required periodically to maintain operational capabilities in the event of a fire.
- The City uses a licensed contractor to provide these services.
- The proposed Agreement provides for the inspection, maintenance, service and testing of fire suppression systems and their appurtenances.

PROPOSED

- On December 21, 2017 IFB 18-04 to acquire fire suppression system inspection services was opened by Purchasing.
- Of the 74 vendors notified, three responses were received and considered responsive.
- Red Hawk Fire & Security (CA), LLC, Fremont, CA submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

BENEFIT

- Ensures all fire suppression systems citywide are compliant with National Fire Protection Association standards.
- Makes certain that the systems and associated equipment are functional at all times.
- Promotes workplace safety and mitigates potential fire damage to City properties.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Finance Department, that Council, by resolution, approve General Services Agreement F001647 for the inspection, maintenance, service and testing of fire suppression systems and their appurtenances to Red Hawk Fire & Security (CA), LLC, of Fremont, CA, in the total amount not to exceed \$300,000.
