BACKGROUND

Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan Update

1. On June 28, 2018, staff presented an update of the Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan to the Advisory Committee. At that meeting, the Committee requested that staff return to present the draft networks.
2. On July 19, 2018, Alta Planning + Design (Consultant) presented the draft recommendations for the bicycle and pedestrian networks to the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Board.
3. On July 25, 2018, the Consultant held an Open House at the Rincon Valley Library to present the draft recommendations for the bicycle and pedestrian networks to the community.

Citywide Creek Master Plan

4. The Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan outlines future bikeway improvements and includes prioritization criteria for pedestrian and bikeway projects. The Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan was reflected in General Plan 2035 in 2009 and updated in 2011. The 2013 CCMP was updated to be consistent with the Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan to help implement the following General Plan policy:

UD-E-1 Provide for new open space opportunities throughout the city, especially in neighborhoods that have less access to open spaces.

This includes exploring potential for creek corridors, bicycle and pedestrian ways, as well as new public plazas, gathering places, and conservation areas.
