

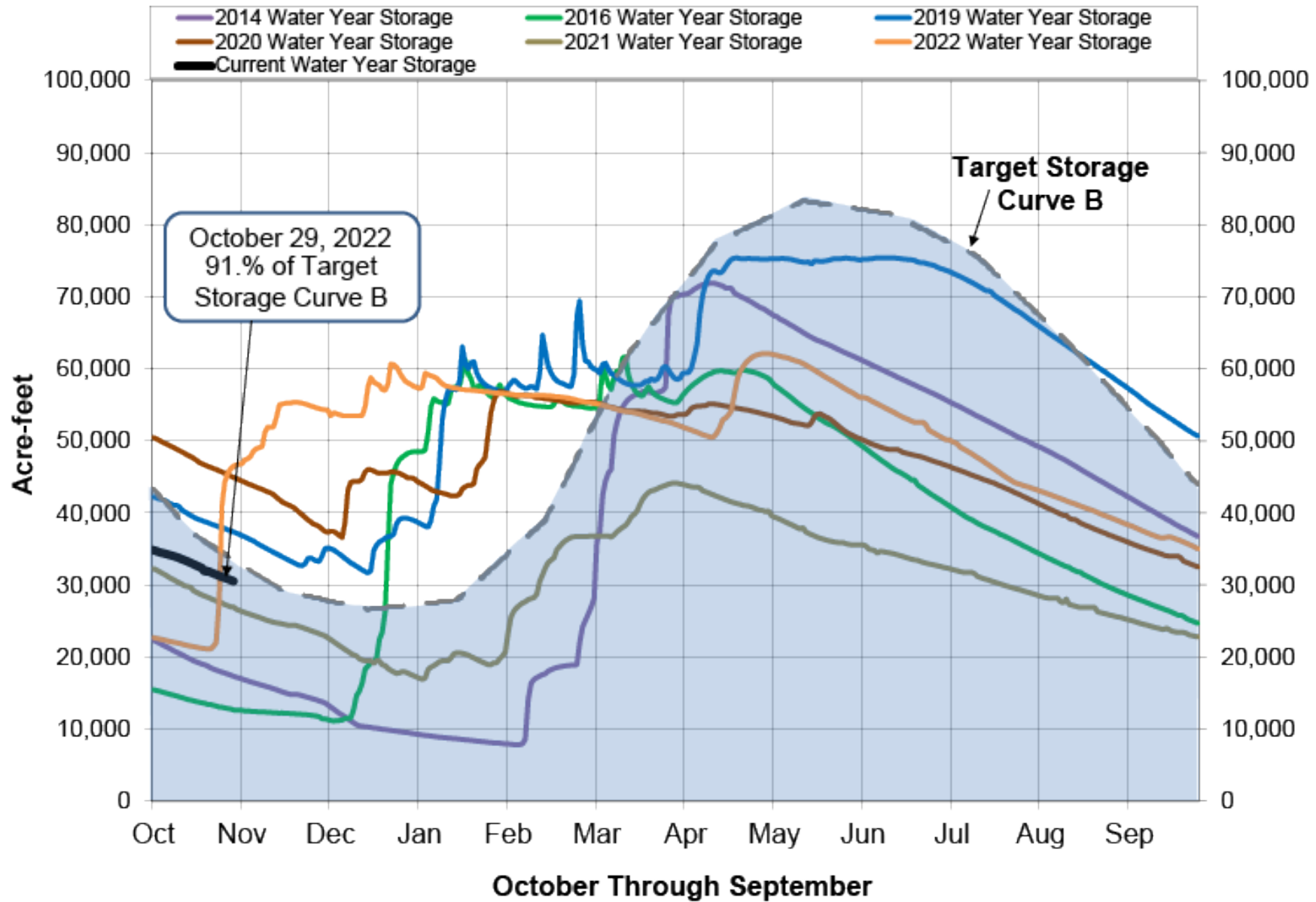

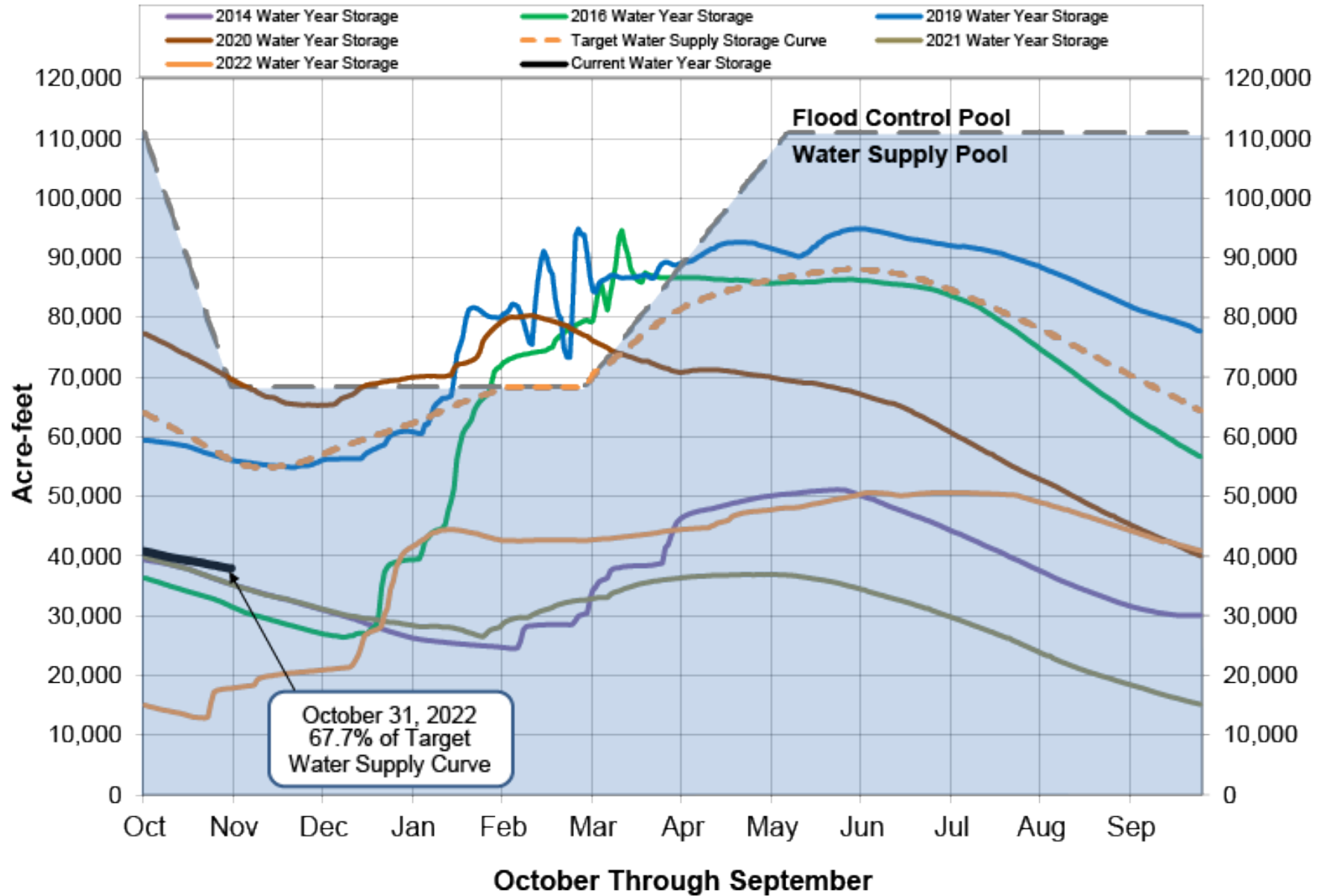

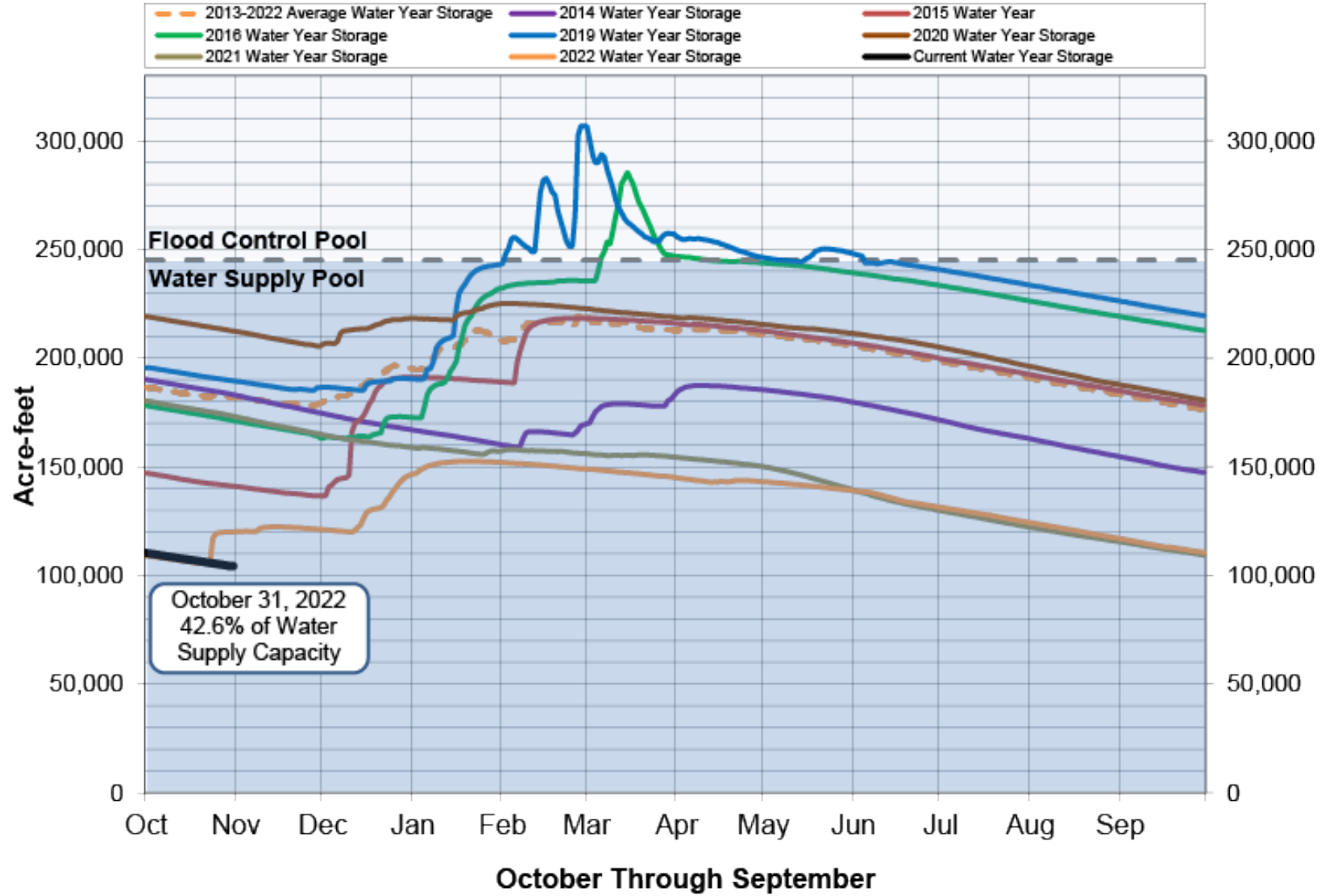
Lake Pillsbury Storage



Lake Mendocino Storage

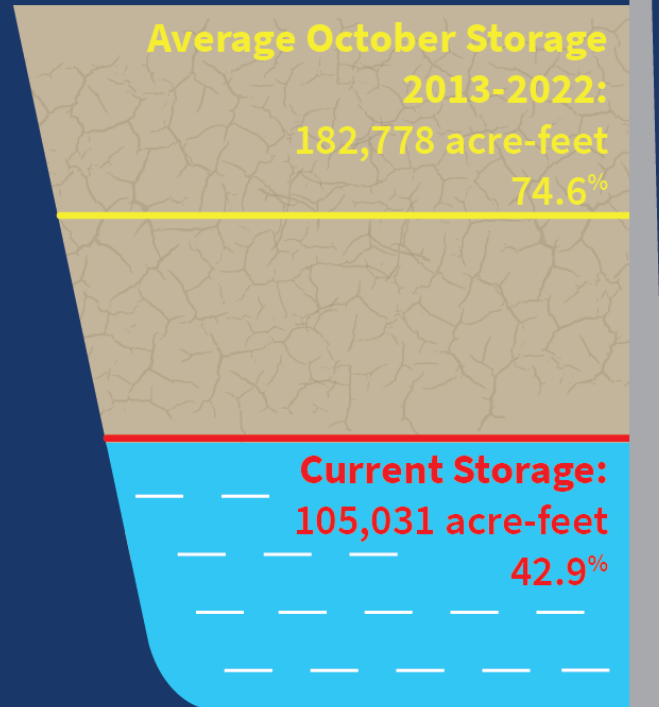


Lake Sonoma Storage



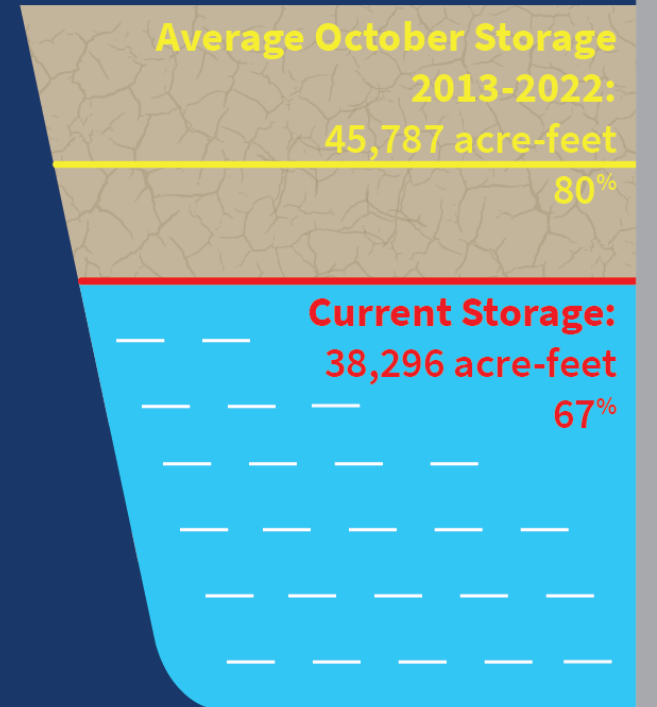
Weekly Water Supply Levels

245,000 acre-feet

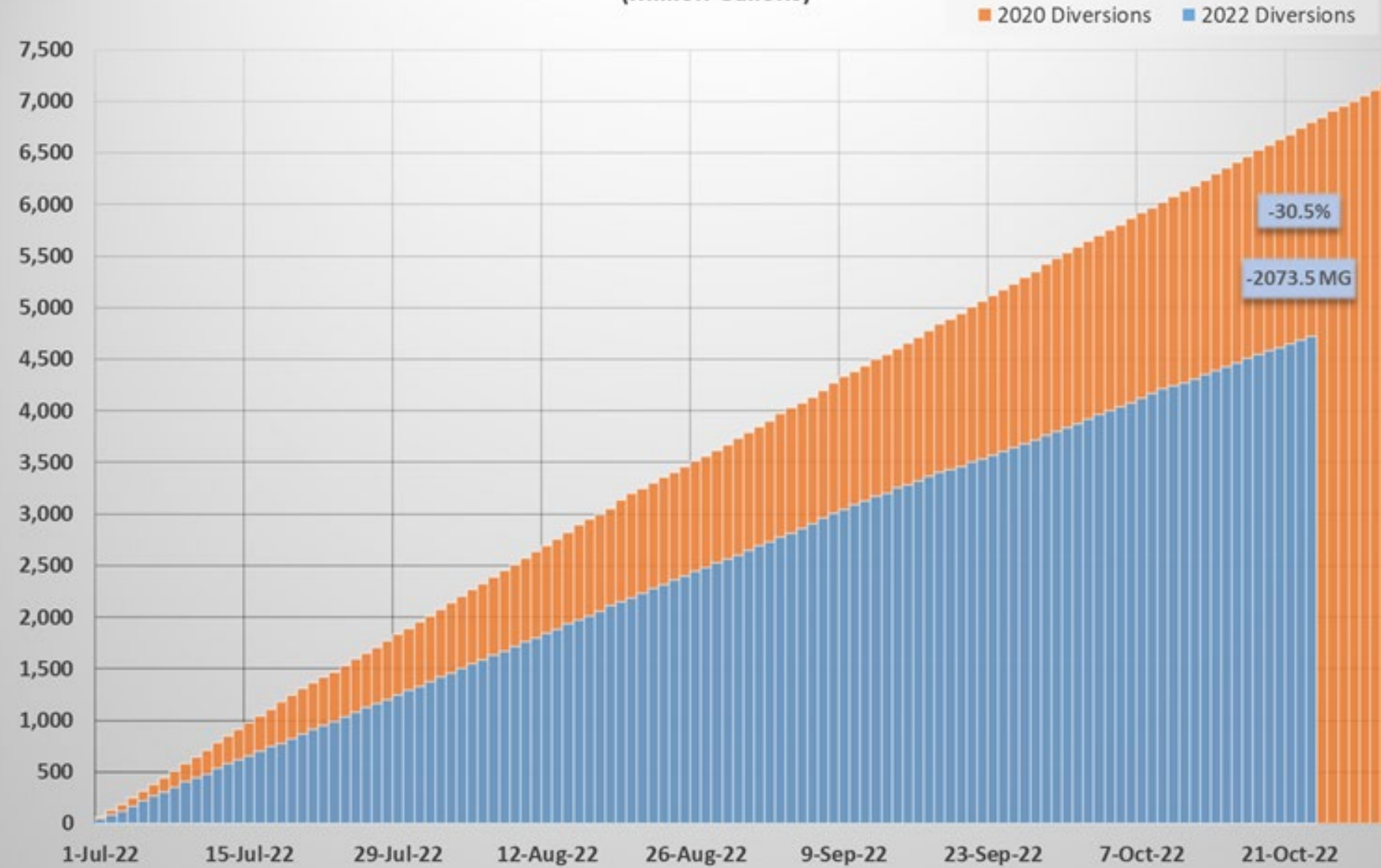
LAKE MENDOCINO

Sonoma Water: Temporary Urgency Change Order

- June 2022 Temporary Change Order Expiring 12/12/2022
 - Minimum instream flows 25 CFS Upper / 35 CFS Lower
 - 20% diversion reduction July 1 – October 31
 - Weekly monitoring reports
- Sonoma Water will file Temporary Urgency Change Petition to hopefully receive a new Order before current Order expires

Key Messaging – November 2022



- Turn OFF your Irrigation
 - Bill inserts
 - Direct outreach to irrigation customers
- Install rainwater harvesting systems
 - Rainwater capture workshop recordings to be posted online
- Be water efficient indoors
- Find and fix leaks in your home
