
Measure M passed in November 2004

2004 PROJECTED vs ACTUAL SALES TAX REVENUE




APPORTIONMENT PROGRAMS AS OF JUNE 30, 2015

- Local Streets Rehabilitation 20% \$37 Million
- Local Bus Transit 10% \$18.5 Million
- Administration 1% \$2 Million

PROJECT PROGRAMS AS OF JUNE 30, 2015


- Rail Program 5% \$19 Million
- Local Streets Projects (LSP) 20% \$40 Million
- Bicycle and Pedestrian (B&P) 4% \$7.5 Million
