CURRENT

- State Transit Assistance (STA) funding from the State of Good Repair (SGR) account authorized under SB1 (2017) is generated from a portion of a new transportation improvement fee on vehicle registration
- The SGR program goal is to provide funding to rehabilitate and modernize California's existing local transit systems

PROPOSED

- Request \$25,611 in SGR funds that Santa Rosa Transportation and Public Works Department will use to maintain and repair the fixed-route fleet of buses.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that the Council, by resolution, approve the SB1 State of Good Repair Project List for FY 2021-22 for preventative maintenance, and authorize the Director of Transportation and Public Works or his designee to request the City's annual allocation of FY 2021-22 State of Good Repair funding in the estimated amount of \$25,611 from the California Department of Transportation.
