### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the City Attorney's Office and Human Resources that the Council, by motion, approve a clerical correction to Resolution RES-2017-159 to clarify need for Legal Services Agreement (Labor).

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

On August 15, 2017, the Council adopted Resolution RES-2017-159 approving a Third Amendment to the Professional Services Agreement with Renne Sloan Holtzman Sakai LLP. A clerical error was discovered in the Recital portion of the resolution at the time of conforming the final resolution. Out of abundance of caution, it has been determined that Resolution RES-2017-159 should be brought back to Council for approval of the correction.

#### <u>BACKGROUND</u>

Due to an inadvertent clerical error, Resolution RES-2017-159 erroneously identified that "specialized labor relations services will be needed due to the impact of thirteen labor agreements expiring June 30, 2018." The language should have instead stated that "additional specialized labor relations services will be needed due to the complexity of current labor laws."

## PRIOR CITY COUNCIL REVIEW

On August 15, 2017, the Council approved Resolution RES-2017-159 on the Consent calendar.

### <u>ANALYSIS</u>

Out of an abundance of caution, it is recommended that Council, by motion, approve correction to RES-2017-159 striking:

"WHEREAS, Human Resources staff determined that additional specialized labor relations services will be needed due to the impact of thirteen labor agreements expiring June 30, 2018; and"

and adding:

"WHEREAS, Human Resources staff determined that additional specialized labor relations services will be needed due to the complexity of current labor laws; and"
