WHEREAS, trees protect our environmental resources; they reduce erosion of topsoil, provide shade, which helps save energy costs for air conditioning, clean the air, produce oxygen, and provide habitat for wildlife. Trees are a renewable resource, giving us paper, construction materials, fuel, and countless other products; and

WHEREAS, trees support our city's economic development; they beautify our community, enhance the vitality of business areas, provide a sense of identity in our neighborhoods, and increase property values; and

WHEREAS, the strengthening of community image and sense of place through the dedication to the preservation of Santa Rosa's urban forest has been a major goal and commitment since the City's founding; and

WHEREAS, Santa Rosa has been recognized as a "Tree City USA" by the National Arbor Day Foundation and desires to continue its tree-planting ways; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that, I, Scott P. Bartley, Mayor of the City of Santa Rosa do hereby proclaim, March 7 - 14, 2013
