

## Park Naming Policy & Procedure

- Adopted by City Council 1989 (30 years ago)
- Amended 1994, 1997, 2000 (minimal changes)
- To date used to name NEW parks
- In 2018 there were two renaming requests

#### **Objectives**

- The name enhances City's values & heritage.
   Compatible with community interest.
- To easily identify parks by geographic location/function
- To encourage land/monetary donations& provide recognition



## Current Procedure: Change of Name

- A park or recreation facility name may be changed if the following conditions are met:
  - A. Occurrence of event of national or local significance. A waiting period of no less than two (2) years between the event and the actual naming of the park is required.

#### OR

B. If the name becomes inappropriate.


#### Mary M. Traverso

- Honorary bench donated in 2016


### Staff Findings

- She is loved by her family and known in the community from Traverso's Market







### Question 1: Where do you live within the City of




## Question 1: Where do you live within the City of Santa Rosa?




#### Question 2: What is your age group?






# Question 6: Have you visited Creekside Open Space?







## Question 7: How often do you visit Creekside Open Space?





Question 10: Are Mary M. Traverso's civic contributions an "occurrence or event of national or local significance"?







**Question 11:** Does changing the Creekside Open Space park name to Mary M. Traverso "enhance the City's values and heritage"?






**Question 12:** Is changing the Creekside Open Space park name to Mary M. Traverso "compatible with community interest"?







Question 13: Are you in favor of changing the name of Creekside Open Space to Mary M. Traverso Open Space? (Data sources comparison)




**Question 13:** Are you in favor of changing the name of Creekside Open Space to Mary M. Traverso Open Space?






Question 14: What percentage of the community should support the naming or renaming of an existing park? (Data sources comparison)

### Staff Findings

- 73% of respondents living in Southeast Santa Rosa support a name change
- 69% of respondents living in Southeast Santa Rosa support a name change if there is 50% or greater support for the name change
- 66% of All Respondents support a name change.
- 64% of All Respondents support a name change if there is 50% or greater support for the name change.
- 62% of respondents living in Santa Rosa support a name change
- 66% of respondents living in Santa Rosa support a name change if there is 50% or greater support for the name change.





#### Staff Recommends

• Approving the park name change from Creekside Open Space to Mary Traverso Open Space with 73% of Southeast resident respondents and 62% of City resident respondents in favor. This is 12% above the threshold of support favored by all meeting attendees and respondents.

#### OR

Retaining the name Creekside
Open Space until the City adopts
an updated Park Naming Policy &
Procedure. The Traverso family
may resubmit their request under
the new policy.

### **Next Steps**

- BOCS recommendation to City Council
- City Council review in July/August
- If approved, update City media with new name
