



# Approve Second Amendment To General Services Agreement (GSA) F000656 With IPS Group, Inc.

# CURRENT

- The Parking Division has an ongoing need to acquire electronic parking meter services and supplies to maintain and operate the City's metered parking program.
- IPS Group, Inc. continues to provide satisfactory services.

# PROPOSED

- The Second Amendment will add funds necessary to facilitate ongoing parking meter services and supplies through the end of the contract term, which expires on December 31, 2020.

# BENEFIT

- Allows the City to replace parking meters at the end of their useful life, and provide ongoing services under the current award by Council from Request for Proposals 13-27 on December 3, 2013.

# RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Finance Department that the Council, by resolution, approve the Second Amendment to General Services Agreement (GSA) F000656 with IPS Group, Inc., San Diego, California, to increase compensation by \$600,000, for a total amount not to exceed \$1,158,121.50.
