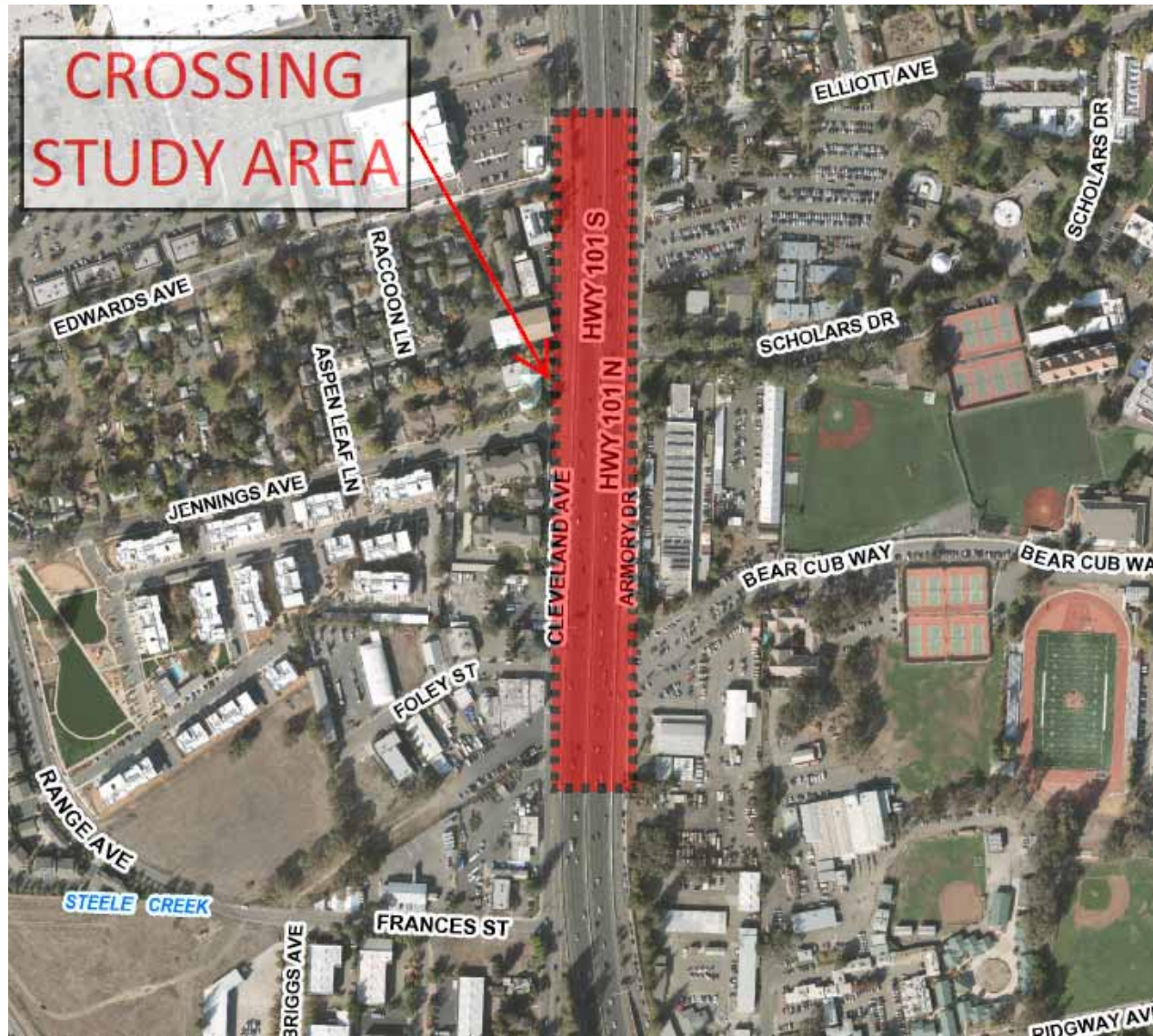

BACKGROUND

- City & Caltrans completed Project Initiation Document phase in 2016.
- Council approved Project Approval & Environmental Documentation Co-Op Agreement for Caltrans' Independent Quality Assurance in 2016.
- PA&ED obtains environmental clearances with an approved Caltrans project alternative.
- Bike/ Ped Bridge connects bicycle network in the northern half of the City of Santa Rosa.
- PA&ED phase will not have a fiscal impact on the General Fund.

- Request For Proposal under Master Professional Service Agreement was released on November 17, 2016.
- 2 firms provided proposals for PA&ED .
- Review panel selected BKF Engineers.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that Council, by motion, approve and authorize the Mayor to execute project work order #A010019-2016-01, for the Project Approval and Environmental Document (PA&ED) phase for the US Highway 101 – Bicycle and Pedestrian Bridge, in the amount of \$907,559.00, with BKF Engineers.
