

RESOLUTION NO. RES-2019-107

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA APPROVING THE DEMOLITION OF STRUCTURES AT DOYLE PARK, ASSESSOR'S PARCEL NO. 009-231-004

WHEREAS, City staff have evaluated structures located at Doyle Park and have determined that certain structures are in poor condition and are not needed for any City use and that it is in the best interest of the City to demolish and remove the structures consisting of a shop storage building, concession stand, ballfield storage building, storage shed and storage building; and

WHEREAS, a historic evaluation of the Doyle Park "log cabin", prepared by Tom Origer & Associates, dated April 18, 2019, concluded that "In our opinion, this building is unlikely to meet the eligibility criteria outlined in the California Code of Regulations (Title 14 CCR, §4852) because it is not an important park feature and its simple architecture lacks distinction."; and

WHEREAS, the proposed demolition project at Doyle Park is categorically exempt pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15301(1) because it involves the demolition and removal of accessory structures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Santa Rosa approves demolition of structures located at Doyle Park.
