

WHEREAS, human trafficking is a multi-billion-dollar trade that occurs in many industries such as the commercial sex, restaurant and construction industries as well in the labor market in general such as domestic servitude; and

WHEREAS, commercially sexually exploited children (CSEC) represent a growing segment of the U.S. human trafficking population. Victims experience extreme forms of trauma, violence, manipulation and even death. The average age of a CSEC brought into the commercial sex trade at the hands of an exploiter is 12-14 years old; and

**WHEREAS**, laws have been enacted to prosecute perpetrators of human trafficking, and to assist and protect victims. But due to the techniques that traffickers use for enslaving their victims, self-reporting is severely limited. Thus, more awareness of the issues surrounding human trafficking is needed by all, especially those most likely to come into contact with victims; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Santa Rosa has a tradition of advancing fundamental human rights and actively opposes all individuals, groups, organizations and governments who support, advance or commit acts of human trafficking; and

**WHEREAS**, individuals, public agencies, private organizations and businesses in the City of Santa Rosa should join together and work to end human trafficking through education.
