

UPCOMING AND ACCOMPLISHED EVENTS for BOCS April 28, 2021

UPCOMING EVENTS:

- March 15 through May 28 – School of Rec continues through the fourth quarter
- April 14 – Adult Softball Registration begins for Men, Coed, Women and Men's Divisions Masters (age 45+) will be offered with COVID safety protocols in place
- April 19 – Finley Aquatics Front Desk re-opens for in-person Registration
- April 30 – Kentucky Derby drive-thru lunch for seniors at Finley Senior Wing parking lot. Seniors encouraged to wear festive hats and receive a FREE Check-Fil-A lunch and spring flower. Pre-registration required
- May 6 – Registration begins for summer programs. We will be offering Camp Wa-tam and Camp Yu-Chi this summer with COVID safety protocols in place.
- May 10- Registration begins for Neighborhood Services summer programs.
- June 5 – Finley Community Center and Steele Lane Community Center will begin rentals in a phased-in approach. We will start with ongoing rentals such as meetings and services.
- June 14 – First Day of Recreational Swim at Finley and Ridgway Pools
- June 20 – Doyle and Franklin Clubhouses reopen for ongoing rental groups
- June 21- Neighborhood Services summer camp program begins at five sites: Steele Lane, Finley, Northwest Community Park, Southwest Community Park and Bayer Park
- June 21 – Finley Person Senior Wing and the Steele Lane Community Center will begin offering senior programs. This will be done in 3 phases as we focus on programs that are compliant with COVID safety guidelines. Some programs in the first phase will include bingo, billiards, card games, Mah Jong, book club, computer lab, Spanish and photography classes.
