

- New Project Air Quality Compliance, \$90,000
- Compost Turner Rebuilding, \$150,000
- Electrical System Upgrades, \$150,000 (moved from CIP)
- Laboratory Equipment Upgrades, \$76,054
- All other 'Equipment Upgrades', \$107,500



OTHER MAJOR O&M LINE ITEM INCREASES

- Salaries Up 8.4% or \$175,137
 - Two new positions
- Operational Supplies Up 12.7% or \$224,940
 - Digester Gas Conditioning Media, \$60,000
 - New Charge Green Waste (Compost), \$85,000
 - Chemicals Nutrient Removal, \$77,000
- Capital Items New \$102,000
 - Two 6" portable pump replacements




2015/16 CIP PROJECT FUNDING

- Planned increases each year in order to avoid more expensive bond funding for routine and smaller capital improvements


