



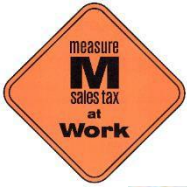

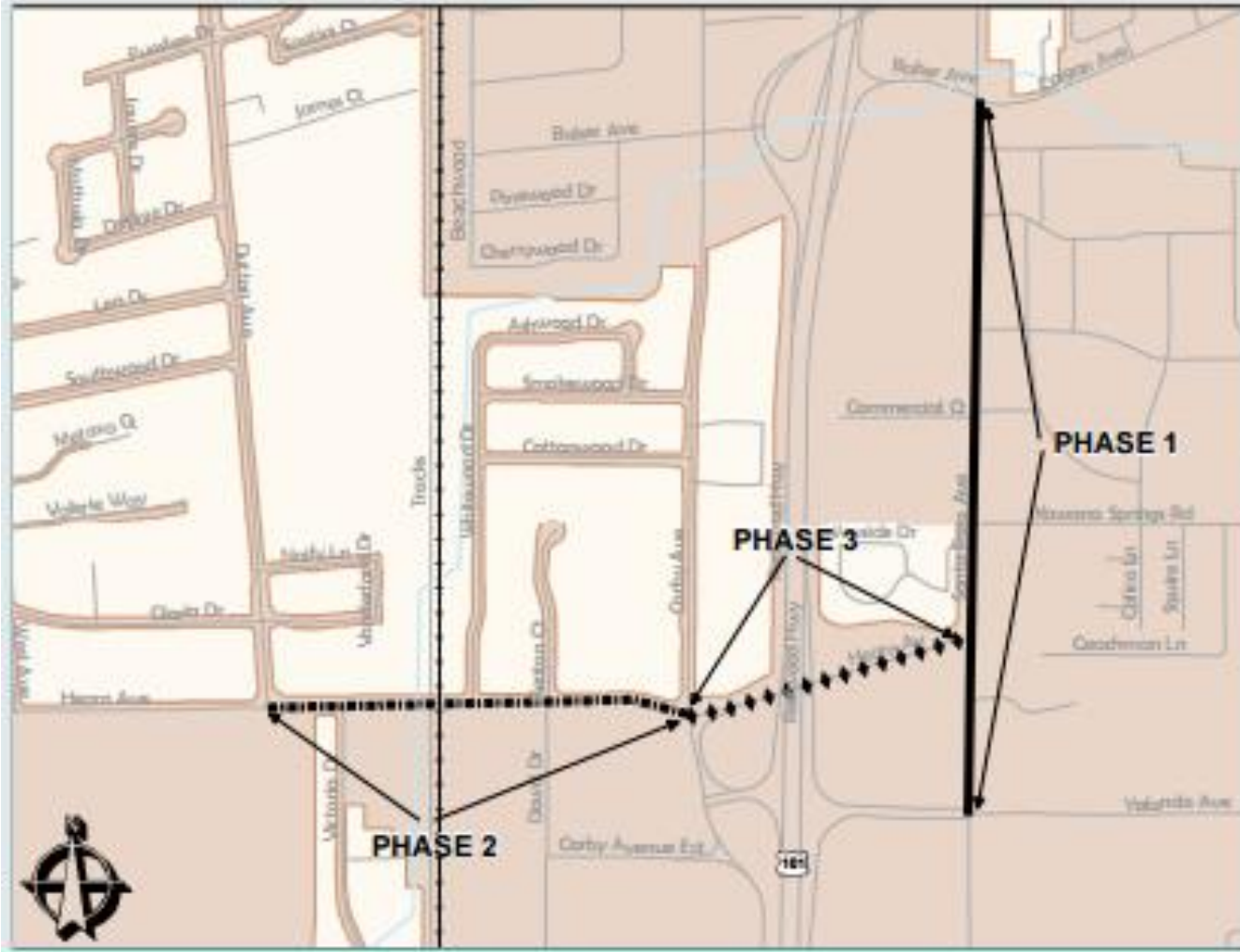
BACKGROUND

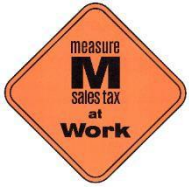
- Improve traffic operation, traffic circulation, overall safety.
- Connectivity for pedestrians, bicyclists, & transit
- PS&E and R/W phase completion scheduled for December 2020
- Caltrans to perform project advertise, award, and administration (AAA).
- Caltrans requires amendment to cooperative agreement for advertise and award.

ANALYSIS

Under this amended agreement:

- City will remain the Implementing Agency for the PS&E phase.
- Caltrans will remain the Implementing Agency for the R/W phase.
- Caltrans will perform the task of awarding and approving the construction contract during the PS&E phase
- Increased cost of \$150,000 for PS&E funding support provided by Caltrans.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that Council, by resolution, approve the Amendment No. 1 to Cooperative Agreement No. 04-2600-A1 between the State of California and the City of Santa Rosa for Quality Management Assessment during the preparation of the project plans, specifications and estimate; right-of-way support; and right-of-way acquisition for the Hearn Avenue Interchange at Highway 101 Project.
