PROJECT OVERVIEW

The project site is located in the McDonald Historic District. The parcel is surrounded by residential homes and the proposed project is congruent with the neighborhood district.

- Lot Size .26 Acres
- General Plan - Low Residential
- Zoning Code PD 0005-H

One-story single-family dwelling with 1873 square feet of living space, covered front porch, and detached 2 car garage. The garage is connected to the house via covered breezeway and is accessed from the alley at the rear of the parcel.

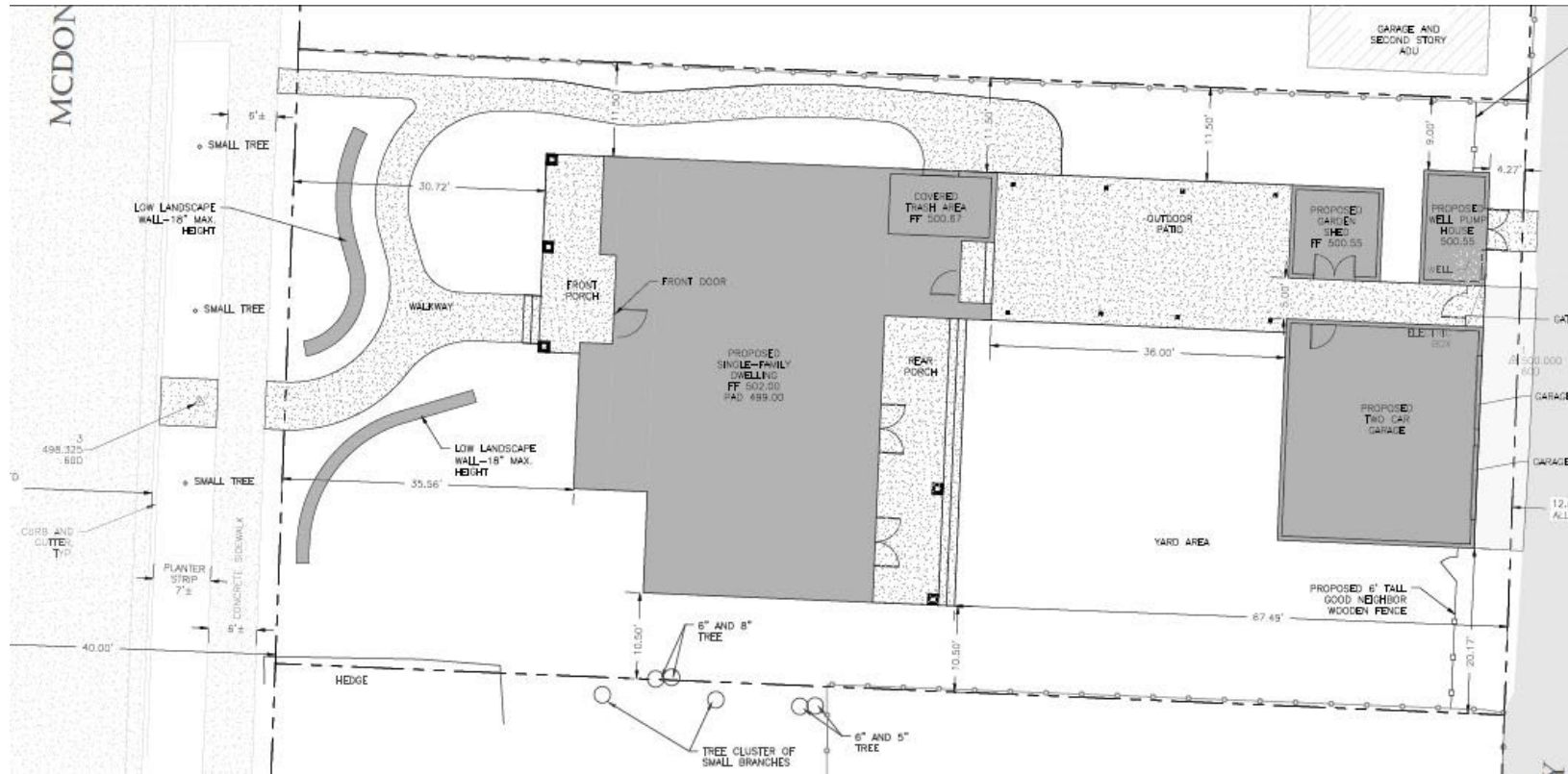

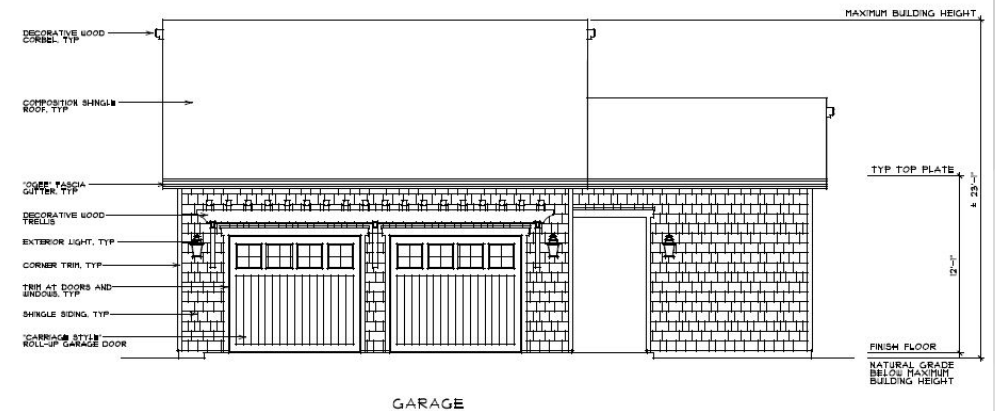

ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN

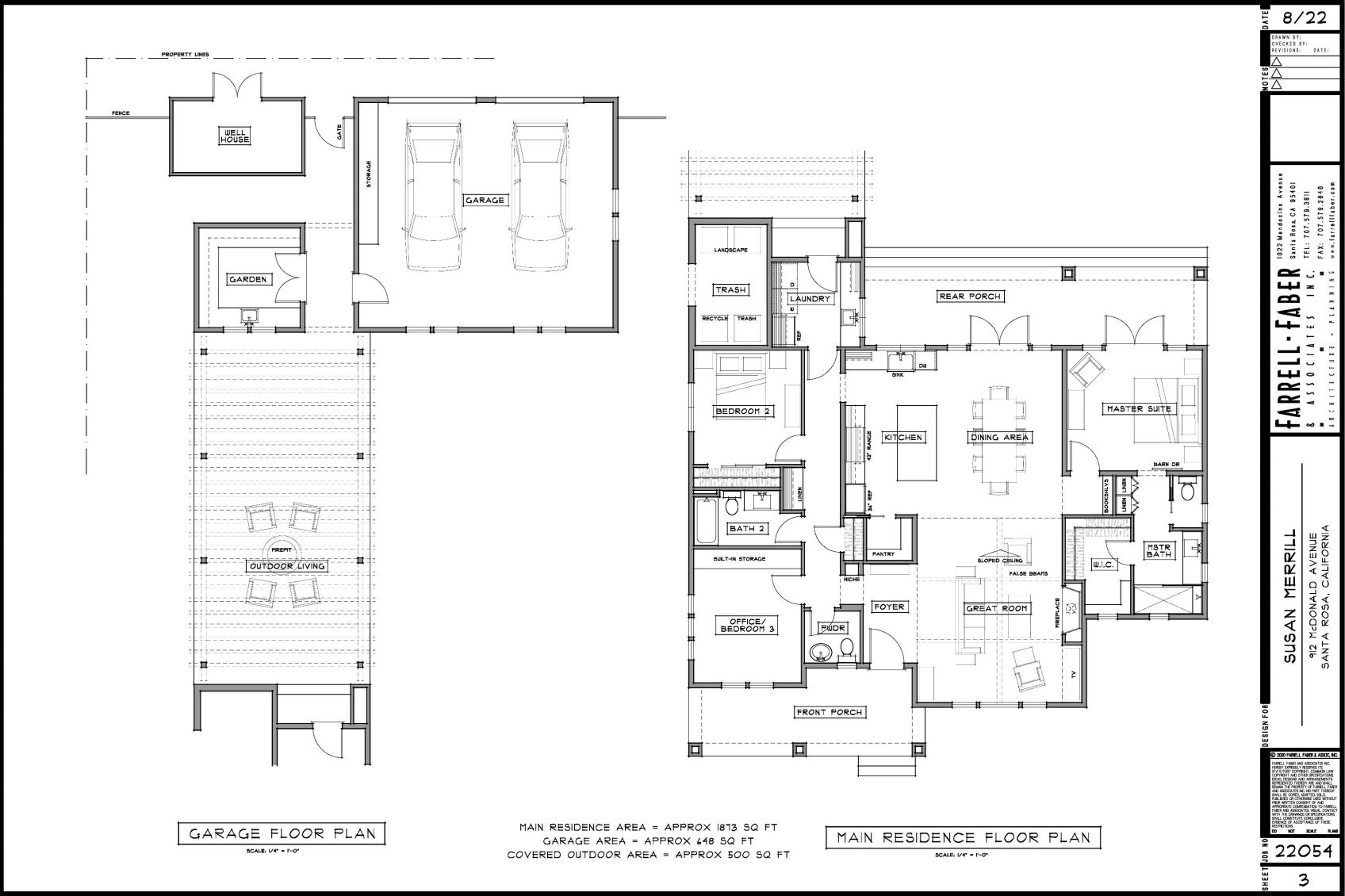


Classic craftsman architecture integrates historical materials such as shingle siding, decorative columns, and steeper pitched roofs.

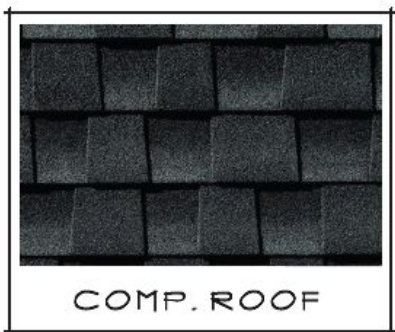
