



Low Carbon Transit Operations Program (LCTOP) Funding Request

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CURRENT

- SB 862 (2014) Transit, Affordable Housing, and Sustainable Communities Program provides for proceeds from Cap and Trade auctions to fund the LCTOP program.
- LCTOP provides assistance to transit operators to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and improve mobility.
- LCTOP uses a formula to distribute funds to transit operators with eligible projects throughout the state based on population and revenue.

PROPOSED

- Request \$371,499 in LCTOP funds that Santa Rosa Transportation and Public Works Department will use to support the operation of Route 1 and Route 2 service instituted as part of CityBus system restructuring.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that Council, by Resolution, 1) authorize the Director of Transportation and Public Works or designee to request an estimated \$371,499 in Low Carbon Transit Operations Program funds to assist in operating the improved service on CityBus Routes 1 and 2; 2) authorize the Director of Transportation and Public Works or designee to execute the certifications and assurances documents; and 3) authorize the Chief Financial Officer to increase appropriations in revenue and expenditures by the approved grant award.
