




Lake Mendocino Storage



Lake Mendocino Storage and Projection




Lake Sonoma Storage





Cumulative Sonoma Water Russian River Diversions (Million Gallons)



Agricultural	1,700	600	580
Urban	400	480	335

~1,400 MG remaining in allocations
