RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF THE 2019 YOUTH REINVESTMENT GRANT APPLICATION TO THE BOARD OF STATE AND COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS FOR FUNDING OF \$2,000,000 FOR THE AWARD PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2020 – JUNE 30, 2023, APPROVING A GRANT AGREEMENT, COMMITTING TO SATISFY MATCHING FUND REQUIREMENTS AND AUTHORIZING THE ASSISTANT CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO SUBMIT THE APPLICATION AND EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT AND ANY AMENDMENTS

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Rosa’s Violence Prevention Partnership invests in and partners with community-based organizations, with an emphasis on school readiness, street outreach and mediation, student engagement and truancy prevention, and workforce development, in addition to a comprehensive array of social services and collaborative opportunities to support high-need areas of Santa Rosa; and

WHEREAS, the Board of State and Community Corrections (hereafter referred to as the BSCC), funded through the California State General Fund, administers the 2019 Youth Reinvestment Grant Program, with \$11,808,818 available for three (3) years aimed at diverting youth who are at risk of initial contact with the juvenile justice system; and

WHEREAS, grant funds may also be used to prevent further involvement for those youth who have already experienced initial contact with the juvenile justice system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Rosa’s Violence Prevention Partnership desires to participate in the 2019 Youth Reinvestment Grant Program and to submit an application for a total of \$2,000,000 for three (3) years; and

WHEREAS, the 2019 Youth Reinvestment Grant Program requires that applicants provide a 25 percent match through cash or in-kind contributions, totaling \$500,000 over a three-year period, which the City anticipates will draw from Measure O supported staff time and funded agencies and have no general fund impact; and

WHEREAS, ninety (90) percent of grant awards will be utilized as pass-through grants awarded to community-based organizations, with ten (10) percent allocated for contracted evaluation services and administrative costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Assistant City Manager over the Community Engagement Division or their designee be authorized on behalf of the Council of the City of Santa Rosa to submit the grant proposal for 2019 Youth Reinvestment Grant funding and sign the Grant Agreement with BSCC, including any amendments thereof, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Santa Rosa agrees to ensure all matching funds required for the above grant are provided and abide by the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the BSCC.
