The following programs are governed by the Housing Authority and managed by Housing & Community Services Department staff:

Rental Assistance Programs

All programs are federally funded by the U.S. Housing and Urban Development (HUD)

1. Housing Choice Vouchers (Section 8)

- a. Santa Rosa voucher holders
- b. Veterans Affairs Supportive Housing (HUD-VASH)
- c. Port-In residents (live in Santa Rosa with a voucher from another jurisdiction)
- d. Project-based vouchers

2. Family Self Sufficiency Grant

a. Education, job training, counseling, etc., to clients living in assisted housing with the goal of achieving self sufficiency

3. Tenant Based Rental Assistance

Federal HOME-funded rental assistance

4. Emergency Housing Vouchers

- a. Funded by American Rescue Plan Act of 2021
- b. Targeted to persons who are: 1) chronically, recently, or at risk or homelessness; or 2) fleeing domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking or human trafficking
- c. Project size reduces with each client that ends participation

Programs are funded by local, state, and federal sources.
