

Executive Summary

Award of contract will begin the year-long community planning process associated with the 57-acre former highway right-of-way in southeast Santa Rosa.

Project involves a General Plan Amendment, Rezoning, and Environmental Impact Report.

Analysis

- Year-long planning process includes broad public engagement, coordination and collaboration with stakeholders
- Robust community engagement process to allow neighbors and residents to help shape the General Plan Amendment
- Stakeholder interviews
- Two community meetings includes mailed notices and door-to-door canvassing

Analysis, cont'd

- Surveys: on-line, hard copy and intercept at up to seven locations
- Project website
- Email list to be utilized and added to through project duration
- Consultant will coordinate all major aspects of the project

Process

- Public Engagement leads to land use alternatives
- Planning Commission and City Council review of alternatives – Study Session
- Selection of Preferred Land Use Alternative
 - Planning Commission
 - City Council
- EIR Preparation
 - General Plan Amendment
 - Rezoning Action
