CURRENT

- Santa Rosa CityBus relies on TDA Article IV and STA funding to provide fixed route and paratransit service within the City of Santa Rosa
- CityBus also uses TDA Article IV funds as local match for federal operating grants
- The FY 2018/19 claim includes approximately \$850,000 in new STA revenues generated by the SB1 gas tax increase that will enable CityBus to maintain current service levels in FY 2018/19

PROPOSED

- Authorize the Director of Transportation & Public Works Department, or his designated representative, to file a funding claim with the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) for the allocation of Transportation Development Act (TDA) Article IV and State Transit Assistance (STA) funds for Fiscal Year 2018/2019.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that the Council, by resolution, authorize the Director of Transportation and Public Works, or designated representative, to file a claim for TDA Article IV and STA funds to the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) for Fiscal Year 2018/2019 in the estimated amount of \$8,897,539.
