

Waiver of Competitive Bidding – C.P. Huntington Locomotive Engine

CURRENT

- New C.P. Huntington engine will replace the 46 year old C.P. Huntington train that is no longer cost effective to repair, and available parts are limited.
- Santa Rosa Parks Foundation raised funds for new train.

PROPOSED

- Market research for this type of equipment has determined that there is a very limited market for product.
- Chance Rides in Wichita, Kansas is the only manufacturer meets all of the City's specification requirements.

BENEFIT

 Purchasing the same manufacture model of engine as our existing passenger coaches eliminates the need to keep inventories of parts and specialized equipment for multiple models, and also simplifies maintenance and technician training.
