




Resolution for the Establishment of an Underground Utility District on Fulton Road between Guerneville Road and Piner Road



- Forming UUD Santa Rosa City Code Chapter 13-12.
- Establishing UUD defines boundaries & affected parcels.
- UUD removes all utility poles.
- Rule 20A Funding is set aside each year and shared with the City.
- PG&E Rule 20A collects funds from ratepayers.
- PG&E requires a public hearing and resolution approval.
- City's allocation balance is \$5,091,062.

ANALYSIS

Resolution would:

- Place UUD in PG&E's queue for project design.
- Prevent future overhead lines, poles, or structures for utility purpose.
- Design and construction cost of UUD (except for street lighting) are paid through credits by the Rule 20A.
- Allows City to remove UUD from PG&E's queue at anytime.

RECOMMENDATION

• It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that Council, by resolution, approve the establishment of an Underground Utility District on Fulton Road between Guerneville Road and Piner Road.
