RE: Senate Bill 504 - Wildfires: defensible space: grant programs: local governments -SUPPORT (As Amended on April 20, 2023)

Dear Senator Dodd:

NATALIE ROGERS Mayor On behalf of the City of Santa Rosa, I write to express our support for Senate Bill (SB) 504, which would give wildfire grant funding priority to jurisdictions that report defensive space inspection data to CalFire's central database.

Vice Mayor Santa Rosa was devastated by the Sonoma Complex Fires in October 2017, which claimed 24 EDDIE ALVAREZ lives, destroyed 3,043 residential units within the City, and caused more than \$70 million in VICTORIA FLEMING damages to critical water and transportation infrastructure, facilities, local businesses, parks and open spaces. Unfortunately, Santa Rosa has experienced multiples fires since 2017, MARK STAPP including the Kincade and Glass Fires that both threatened and directly impacted our community.

> SB 504 would require CalFire, when it reviews applications for the local assistance grant program, to give priority to any local governmental entity that is qualified to perform defensible space assessments in high fire hazard severity zones. This would restore the incentive for qualified entities to report defensive space inspection data to CalFire's central database.

> Additionally, SB 504 would clarify how the effectiveness of wildfire defensive space around a structure is assessed by eliminating the reference to "average" weather conditions when assessing the effectiveness of defensive space around a structure and its likelihood of preventing the ignition of that structure during a wildfire, which would strengthen the viability of defensible space around a home.
